HCI GIVING AT A GLANCE

THE JOSEPH MALEY FOUNDATION

Joseph Maley Foundation celebrates differences and cultivates an inclusive community through education and service of youth in Greater Indianapolis. Through HCI's generous grants, JMF has seen exceptional growth in programming and with their aid has been able to serve an additional 250,000 youth, bringing our total served since 2008 to 350,000.

IVY TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE

HCI's generous support has significantly reduced the financial barrier for students interested in pursuing Healthcare Specialist certificate programs- CNA, Pharmacy Tech, and Dementia Care. Because of support from HCI and others, Ivy Tech can train 40 CNA students, 24 Pharmacy Technician students, and 30 Dementia Care Students per year.

MARIAN UNIVERSITY

Marian University College of Osteopathic Medicine is celebrating its 10th Anniversary - graduating its seventh class and over 1000 graduates. The overall debt reported by 2021 graduates is \$257,335 nationally. The Healthcare Initiatives, Inc. Primary Care Endowed Scholarship has provided crucial financial assistance to our students allowing them to pursue their dreams with less financial risk. HCI's generosity is a reminder to our students that they have a community of support behind them.

CHILDREN'S ORGAN TRANSPLANT ASSOCIATION

Thanks to HCI's support, COTA now accepts online expense reimbursement submissions, allowing hundreds of families access to submit expenses online and receive an electronic direct deposit - totaling more than 6,000 individual transactions in the past year. The ease of this system allows for COTA families to focus on their child and not worry about the financial burden.

REACH FOR YOUTH

HCI's support has helped Reach for Youth implement and facilitate this one-of-a-kind academic and employment readiness program that includes positive mental health, emotional and social skills, and "learning to earn" strategies. Since the launch of this project, a total of 318 youth have been introduced to the R.E.A.C.H program!

ESKENAZI HEALTH FOUNDATION

The generous support from HCI has undoubtedly promoted the advancement of human health and well-being by meaningfully addressing the devastating opioid crisis in Marion County through support to Project POINT at Eskenazi Health. HCI's support helps to fund the program facilitators and patients as they work to maintain sobriety and face barriers to their recovery.
